Kilkenny duo Pat Hayes and Seamus Moore, who joined forces for a few concert dates last year, are back together for four shows in early April. Under the banner of 2 Tuff Yokes, the lads are all set for shows in Cork, Kerry and Tipperary.

Seamus left Callan in his teenage years and has spent most of his life in the London area where he currently runs the Conways Three pub.
